







# **GLOPEM Double Degree Master Programmes**

## CALL for the Academic Year 2025-2026

The **GLOPEM Double Degree** (DD) Master programme selects GLOPEM students to spend one or two semesters of year II at one partner institution, namely the University of Liège (ULg), Université de Paris XII Est Créteil (UPEC) and University of Flensburg (EUF).

GLOPEM DD students are enrolled at the partner institution for one (at UPEC and EUF) or two (at ULg) semesters and undertake the study plan as described on the partner's website. Students may wish to check also the GLOPEM DD website: <u>http://www.dsps.unict.it/it/internazionale/doppio-titolo</u>

DD students are expected to pass all exams of their study plan and discuss their dissertation at UNICT by the end of their second academic year in order to receive a degree title from ULg/UPEC/EUF on top of the Master Degree released by the University of Catania.

DD candidates must have **accomplished the GLOPEM study plan related to Semester I** and have fully **succeeded all exams with an average grade of 26/30**. They are requested to send the following documents **by 12<sup>th</sup> March 2025**:

a. the transcript of records of all GLOPEM exams related to semester I;

b. a letter of interest and motivation to participate in the chosen program, containing also the exam plan related to year I, attesting that all exams will be passed no later than September 2025;

c. a **CV** (non-European format) with evidence of relevant extra-curricular experiences specifying the BA final mark;

d. ULg and UPEC DD candidates must provide adequate certification to prove that they have the required knowledge of **French language (B2 level)** or will have to pass an interview in French.

**Applications must be sent to Prof. Stefania Panebianco** <u>stefania.panebianco@unict.it</u>, who is in charge of the DD portfolio, and copied to the **Chair of the GLOPEM Master, Prof. Marcello Carammia** <u>marcello.carammia@unict.it</u>.

The GLOPEM Academic Board assesses the applications and makes the rankings. Selected candidates will be nominated to the hosting Institution no later than 1<sup>st</sup> May 2025. Students are responsible for fulfilling all administrative requirements set by the hosting institution within the set deadlines.

Funding might be made available by UNICT or other donors. ERASMUS grants may be a valid option.

**NOTA BENE:** As stated in the Conventions with the partner universities, selected GLOPEM students are required to pass all exams of year I before starting the degree programme in the partner university.
